Tips for making it easy for your aging dog and you!

Use this handy checklist when you go shopping for your senior dog:

- Belly bands
- Right kind of incontinence pads!
- Wee pads
- Toxic-free cleaning supplies
- Mattress covers
- Yoga mats, rugs for traction
- Booties
- Stairs
- Ramps (to couch, into cars)
- Seat belts, beds, crates in cars to hold them in place
- Harness instead of collars
- Harness help (walkabouts, hip helpers)
- Grass pads
- Calms Forte
- Elevate food/water bowls
- Baby pens/gates for safety from falling down stairs, confining to an area, etc.
- Doggy strollers
- Baby slings or frontpack for carrying small dogs
- Toothbrush to preserve what teeth they have
- Soft toys/treats for those with little or no teeth
- Sweaters/shirts/jackets
- Doggy doors to access outdoor areas (seniors need to pee more often)
